RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 297965

ADOPTED ON MAY 20 2003

WHEREAS, the 303 Coast Boulevard Storm Drain Replacement project will eliminate the flooding problem at the end of Scripps Lane alley and will relocate the drain pipe from under the buildings at 303 Coast Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, preconstruction potholing revealed two unforeseen conditions that resulted in additions to the scope of work and requires additional funding; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$74,296 from CIP 17-001.0, Minor Drain and Seepage Problems, to CIP 11-301.0, Coast Boulevard Drain, TransNet Funds.


2. That an additional expenditure in the amount of \$74,296 from TransNet Funds is authorized solely and exclusively for the purpose of additional construction costs for CIP 11-301.0, Coast Boulevard Drain, provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

3. That the Auditor and Comptroller, upon the direction of the City Manager, is authorized to reallocate the funding sources for TransNet Funds between TransNet Cash and

Commercial Paper funded projects as may be appropriate to maximize the use of TransNet Cash and reduce the use of Commercial Paper for funding CIP 11-301.0, Coast Boulevard Drain.

4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to return excess funds, if any, to CIP 17-001.0, Minor Drain and Seepage Problems.
