RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESCINDING THE EXISTING DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES FOR THE SOUTHEASTERN SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY AND ESTABLISHING NEW DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES FOR ALL PROPERTY WITHIN THE SOUTHEASTERN SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that it rescinds the existing Development Impact Fees [DIF] for the Southeastern San Diego community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the DIF fee schedule contained in the Southeastern San Diego Public Facilities Financing Plan, Fiscal Year 2003, May 2003, as adopted and approved on JUN 102003003, by Resolution No. R-298061 [R-2003-1188], is declared to be an appropriate and applicable DIF fee schedule for all properties within the Southeastern Community Planning Area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Docket Supporting Information [City Manager's Report No. <u>03-078</u>] and the text contained in the Southeastern Public Facilities Financing Plan, Fiscal Year 2003, May 2003, a copy of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-<u>298061</u> [R-2003-1188], are incorporated by reference into this resolution as support and justification for satisfaction of findings required pursuant to California Government Code sections 66001(a) and 66001(b) for imposition of DIFs. Specifically, it is determined and found that this documentation:

- 1. Identifies the purpose of the DIF;
- 2. Identifies the use to which the DIF is to be put;
- 3. Demonstrates how there is a reasonable relationship between the DIF's use and the type of development project on which the DIF is imposed; and
- 4. Demonstrates how there is a reasonable relationship between the need for the public facility and the type of development project on which the DIF is imposed.
