

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 298093

ADOPTED ON JUN 17 2003

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an agreement with the Service Authority for Freeway Emergencies [SAFE], to implement a countywide seasonal Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program to be operated, managed, and administered by the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Number RR- 298093 - 1, contingent on the receipt of funding from SAFE, the County of San Diego, and private donations for this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is further authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an agreement with the County of San Diego, to implement a countywide seasonal Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program to be operated, managed, and administered by the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Number RR- 298093 - 2, contingent on the receipt of funding from SAFE, the County of San Diego, and private donations for this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is further authorized and empowered to award and execute, for and on behalf of the City, an agreement with Kachina Aviation, to provide helicopter services for the countywide seasonal Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program, in conformance with the terms and conditions set forth in the bid documents, on file in


the office of the City Clerk as Document Number RR- 298093-3, contingent on the receipt of funding from SAFE, the County of San Diego, and private donors for the Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is further authorized to accept funds and expend funds received from SAFE, the County of San Diego, and private donors for the Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is further authorized to seek, accept, and expend additional funding to extend the Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program and, correspondingly, to amend or modify any agreements in connection therewith which the City Manager shall deem necessary from time to time in order to carry out the purposes and intent of the Fire and Rescue Helicopter Program.
