RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 298105 ADOPTED ON JUN 172003

WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code provides a procedure for the summary vacation of public street easements by City Council resolution where the easement is no longer required; and

WHEREAS, the affected property owner has requested the vacation of the alley in Block 182 of Map 1651 to facilitate development of the site; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that:

- (a) there is no present or prospective use for the public street easement, either for the facility for which the right-of-way was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated in that the right-of-way is not needed for public street, bikeway, or open space purposes;
 - (b) the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land;
- (c) the vacation does not adversely affect the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and
- (d) the public street system or service easement system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the alley vacation, as more particularly described in the legal description, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and as shown on Drawing No. 19767-B, attached hereto as Exhibit "B", is ordered vacated.

2. That this resolution shall not become effective unless and until:

a. The applicant shall cut, plug and physically abandon or relocate any existing

facilities into Strand Way public right-of-way. The relocation of all facilities shall

be per the most current edition of the "Greenbook" - Standard Specifications for

Public Works Construction and the City of San Diego Water and Sewer Design

Guide. All facilities must be operational and accepted in a manner satisfactory to

the City Engineer.

b. In the event the above condition is not completed within three years following the

adoption of this resolution, then this resolution shall become void and be of no

further force or effect.

3. That the City Engineer advise the City Clerk of the completion of the aforementioned

conditions, and the City Clerk shall then cause a certified copy of this resolution with attached

exhibits, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder.


