

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 298125

ADOPTED ON JUN 24 2003

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND EXPENDITURE OF STATE GRANT FUNDS AND CONCESSION FUNDS FOR OCEAN BEACH PIER STRUCTURAL SURVEY.

WHEREAS, the California State Coastal Conservancy (CSCC) considers public access to shoreline, beaches, and piers among its highest funding priorities, and manages grant funds for projects carried out by local governments and non-profit organizations that increase the public's access to, and enjoyment of, the coast; and

WHEREAS, Ocean Beach Fishing Pier [Pier] in the Ocean Beach community was built in 1966 and extends 2,510 feet into the Pacific Ocean; and

WHEREAS, the life expectancy of the Pier was 50 years, and over the years the Pier has sustained the force of wave impacts from seasonal storms and high winds and, as a result, has experienced many closings due to public safety issues; and

WHEREAS, a structural survey (performed last in 1988) will inspect the Pier above and below the waterline to determine its stability and provide engineering recommendations for Pier improvements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to apply to the California State Coastal Conservancy for a grant in the amount of \$125,000, to perform a structural integrity survey of the Ocean Beach Fishing Pier.

2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure, accept and expend grant funds from the CSCC for a structural integrity survey of the Ocean Beach Fishing Pier, including entering into and executing a grant funding agreement.

3. The Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant, if secured.

4. The Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to reprogram \$80,000 from the Ocean Beach Pier Concessions revenue fund #10575 to CIP 29-675.0.

5. The Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend funds if the grant is secured.

6. The Auditor and Comptroller, is authorized, upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement, to increase the Fiscal Year 2003 Capital Improvements Program Budget by adding CIP No. 29-675.0, Ocean Beach Fishing Pier Structural Survey, in the amount of \$205,000.

7. The Auditor and Comptroller, is authorized, upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement, to appropriate and expend \$205,000 from CIP No. 29-675.0, Ocean Beach Fishing Pier Structural Survey, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
