A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO REVISE THE RATEBOOK OF CITY FEES AND CHARGES TO ADD FEES CHARGED FOR SPECIAL EVENTS APPLICATIONS, PRIVATE EVENTS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY, AND FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONAL SUPPORT FEES.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of San Diego to establish fees to recover the costs of providing services; and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2003, a public hearing was held by the Council of the City of San Diego at which oral and written presentations were made regarding the new and revised fees; and

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2003, another public hearing was held by the Council of the City of San Diego at which oral and written presentations were made regarding the new private events on public property fees; and

WHEREAS, ten days prior to the public hearing, Manager's Report No. 03-116, regarding Approval of Rate Revision, New Fee, and Cost Recovery Recommendations, was made available to the public that included a detailed explanation of the proposed revisions to the fees to be considered at the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, to ensure cost recovery for services provided, it is necessary to amend the City Ratebook to include the Special Event Application Fee, the Private Event Fee, and the Fire Department Operational Support Fee [The New Fees]; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that it hereby finds The New

Fees are reasonably calculated to offset the cost of providing the services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Private

Event Fees shall not apply to any lessee or holder of a Non-Exclusive Use Permit [Permit] under

a circumstance where the lessee or holder of the Permit is obligated to pay the City of San Diego

percentage rents based on gross revenues and the total cost of the special event is included within

the gross revenues received.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to review The

New Fees annually to ensure that all reasonable costs incurred in providing services are being

recovered and to adjust and revise the fee schedules in accordance with the City of San Diego

Administrative Regulation 95.25.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby directed to amend the City

Ratebook to include The New Fees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The New Fees will become effective upon approval

of this resolution.
