WHEREAS, on June 30, 2003, Carol Cross retired from Hearst Elementary School, where she contributed her talents and expertise to improve the quality of education at the school; and

WHEREAS, because of her many years at Dailard Elementary School, Carol Cross remembers her time there as an opportunity to work with some of the finest teachers in San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,
