WHEREAS, C.J. Middendorf is a graduate of San Diego State University; and

WHEREAS, her love of education led C.J. Middendorf to become a teacher with San Diego City Schools, beginning at Benchley/Weinberger and Valencia Park Elementary Schools; and

WHEREAS, C.J. Middendorf became a sixth-grade teacher at Ralph C. Dailard Elementary School in 1975; and

WHEREAS, after 18 years, C.J. Middendorf left Dailard Elementary School to help open Kumeyaay Elementary School in September 1994, to teach the fifth and sixth grades; and

WHEREAS, in September 1998, C.J. Middendorf joined the faculty of newly-opened Thurgood Marshall Middle School, where she continued to teach sixth grade, in addition to math to upper grade levels; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of her academic and teaching talents, C.J. Middendorf was selected as Outstanding Math Teacher in San Diego County in 1993 and served on the board of the California Math Council; and


WHEREAS, C.J. Middendorf has served as a math and science presenter for the San Diego Unified School District and a mentor teacher for over 10 years, and she was nominated to represent Thurgood Marshall Middle School for Teacher of the Year in 1999; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2003, C.J. Middendorf retired from Thurgood Marshall Middle School after many years of dedicated service to her students; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize C.J. Middendorf for her outstanding role as teacher and friend to many students in our community.
