ADOPTED ON SEP 22 2003

WHEREAS, Proposition 53 is a constitutional amendment that would set aside state budget dollars each year for infrastructure projects; and


WHEREAS, Proposition 53 will appear on the October 7, 2003 special election ballot; and,

WHEREAS, Proposition 53 would require a percentage of the state's General Fund to be dedicated to maintaining and building infrastructure such as roads, transportation, water systems, parks and open space; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Governmental Relations Department's recommendations generally supporting Proposition 53 but authorizing the Government Relations Department to work with the League of California Cities to prevent reduction of other local government revenues, as outlined in the memo to the Honorable Mayor & Members of the Committee on Rules, Finance & Intergovernmental Relations, dated September 12, 2003, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-298403 are hereby approved.
