WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has broadened the scope of this awareness campaign by including in this celebration San Diego businesses, parks, beaches, sports, arts and all other services, products and places enjoyed by San Diegans, and throughout the month of October, the City is offering a series of awareness programs to San Diego businesses and the community; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council does hereby commend the hundreds of volunteer disabled citizens and the citywide staff for their commitment to help make all San Diegans aware of the rights and needs of citizens with all types of disabilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that October 2003, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "DISABILITY AWARENESS MONTH" in the City of San Diego.
