A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING THE CORTEZ HILL PARKING STUDY AND ESTABLISHING A RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA IN THE CORTEZ REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT - CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego [the "Council"] adopted the Comprehensive Downtown, Parking Plan ["the Plan"] and designated the Centre City Development Corporation as the Parking Meter District 1 Advisory Board [the "District Board"] and is empowered to recommend programs to the Council that will implement solutions to Centre City Parking Problems; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement the Plan, the District Board recommends accepting the Cortez Hill Parking Study and establishing a Residential Permit Parking Area in the Cortez Redevelopment District; and

WHEREAS, the Residential Permit Parking Area boundary will be 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue on the west,

Date Street on the north, 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue on the east, "A" Street on the south, as illustrated in

Attachment 1; and

WHEREAS, the Plan is in the best interest of the City and health, safety, morals and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposes and provisions of applicable State and local law requirements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

- 1. That the City Council finds and determines that the proposed establishment of the residential permit parking area will not be detrimental to the public health, safety, or welfare;
  - 2. That the City Council accepts the Cortez Hill Parking Study;

- 3. That the City Council authorizes the District Board to conduct a follow-up study; and
- 4. That the City Council establish the Cortez Hill Residential Permit Parking Area.
