A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RATIFYING THE ELECTION RESULTS OF OCTOBER 7, 2003, FOR THE COLLEGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT, PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, on September 22, 1992, the Council of the City of San Diego [Council] by Resolution No. R-280718, adopted the Procedures for the Formation of a Project Area Committee [PAC] for the College Community Redevelopment Project [Project]; and

WHEREAS, the annual election was conducted on October 7, 2003, after notice and according to the Project PAC bylaws and procedures enumerated within the documents approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2003, the Council by Resolution No. R-298306 authorized the extension of the PAC for one year; and

WHEREAS, a representative from the City Clerk's office attended the October 7, 2003, election to ensure its validity; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code section 33386, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency], through its staff, shall consult with the PAC for a three-year period after the adoption of the Redevelopment Plan, and for one-year extensions thereafter by approval of the Council; and


WHEREAS, the elected members of the PAC have submitted to Agency staff information establishing the qualifications of each person relative to district, category or organization as appropriate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the persons elected as members of the Project Area Committee for the College Community Redevelopment Project Area, as noted by the City Clerk's verification of the election results of October 7, 2003, attached as Exhibit "A", and incorporated by this reference, are approved as newly elected members to the PAC.
2. That the Council concurs that the election results of October 7, 2003 are valid and binding in accordance with the procedures so adopted by Resolution No.
