A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A MUNICIPAL SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON MARCH 2, 2004, WITH THE STATEWIDE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE.

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on NOV 0 3 2003, the City Council adopted

Ordinance No. O- 19235 (N.S.) calling a Municipal Special Election to submit to the qualified voters of the City various propositions; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on NOV 0 3 2003, the City Council adopted

Ordinance No.(s) 0-19234 (N.S.), placing separate

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this Municipal Special Election be consolidated with the Statewide Primary Election to be held on the same date; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that within the City of San Diego the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the elections be the same; and

propositions on the March 2, 2004 ballot; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the Municipal Special Election; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this Municipal Special Election and the Statewide Primary Election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, in the year 2004 the Statewide Primary Election will be held on the 2nd day of March; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has adopted or will adopt an ordinance calling for a Municipal Special Election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the Municipal Special Election to be held in the City of San Diego on March 2, 2004, with the Statewide Primary Election to be held on the same date.
- 2. The exact form of the proposition(s) to be voted upon at the Municipal Special Election and as they are to appear on the ballot is as they are shown in Ordinance No(s).

 (N.S.). Each proposition shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the proposition as provided in Section 13116 of the Elections Code of the State of California.
- 3. That the Registrar of Voters is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of the Municipal Special Election and is requested to conduct the election in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
- 4. That the Registrar of Voters is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the Statewide Primary Election appropriate instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.
- 5. That the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County of San Diego shall be reimbursed in full for the services performed by the Registrar of Voters for the City of San Diego in connection with the election services herein described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of San Diego agrees to indemnify and to save free and harmless the County, its officers, agents, and employees from expense or liability, including reasonable attorney fees, as a result of an election contest initiated pursuant to the provisions of California Elections Code sections 16000 through 16900.
