
WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego on October 20, 2003, adopted Ordinance No. O-19227 (New Series) entitled, "An Ordinance Submitting To The Qualified Voters Of The City Of San Diego At The Municipal Election Consolidated With The California State General Election To Be Held On March 2, 2004, One Proposition, Relating To Increasing The City's Transient Occupancy Tax By 2.5 Percent"; and
