
WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for a grant pursuant to the Grant Program [Grant] to implement the following: the Marron Valley Fire Management Plan, the Genetic Testing of Fairy Shrimp and Toads, Spring Canyon Vernal Pool Fencing, and the MSCP Biological Monitoring Plan [Projects]; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager or his representative is authorized to apply to the NCCP for the Grant for the Projects.
2. That the City Manager or his representative is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure the Grant and to negotiate and execute all agreements necessary to comply with the NCCP's grant requirements.
3. That the City Manager is authorized to accept the Grant if it is secured.

4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the Grant.
