A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING THE CENTRAL INTERSTATE I-5 FREEWAY DEFICIENCY PLAN.

WHEREAS, a local jurisdiction is required by state law to prepare and adopt a deficiency plan [Plan] when a freeway segment on the regional Congestion Management Program [CMP] network fails to meet the applicable level of service standard; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 65089.4(c) requires a Plan to include identification of the cause of the deficiency, a list of improvements necessary to correct the deficiency and relieve congestion, and an action plan for implementing the improvements in the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Plan is a requirement of the Final Subsequent Environmental Impact Report [FSEIR] for the Ballpark and Ancillary Development project in East Village, dated October 26, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the City, Caltrans, and the Congestion Management Agency [SANDAG] have cooperatively prepared a Plan to identify improvements on the freeways serving Centre City; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that it adopts the Central Interstate I-5 Freeway Deficiency Plan, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 298628.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is directed to forward the Central I-5 Freeway Deficiency Plan to SANDAG (acting as the regional Congestion Management Agency) for acceptance.
