WHEREAS, on August 2, 1999, the City and Tetra Tech (under the name of ASL Consulting Engineers) entered into an Agreement for Professional Services, which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-292037, to provide planning and design services for the rehabilitation of Sewer Pump Station 18 and the replacement of Sewer Pump Station 19 (the Agreement); and,

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2000, the City and Tetra Tech (under the name of ASL Consulting Engineers) entered into a First Amendment to the Agreement, which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-293649, for additional Professional Services relating to the rehabilitation of Sewer Pump Station 18 and the replacement of Sewer Pump Station 19 (the First Amendment); and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to compensate Tetra Tech for Professional Services relating to the rehabilitation of Sewer Pump Station 18 and to compensate Tetra Tech for Professional Services relating to the replacement of Sewer Pump Station 19; and,

WHEREAS, the City has already compensated Tetra Tech in the amount of \$760,206 for its Professional Services under the Agreement and the First Amendment; and,

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment to the Agreement with Tetra Tech will extend the total term of the Agreement beyond five years; and,

WHEREAS, under San Diego Charter section 99 no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance adopted by a two-thirds' majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, Amendment No. 2 to the Agreement with Tetra Tech, for additional engineering consulting services for Sewer Pump Stations 18 and 19

Rehabilitation/Replacement Project, in an amount not to exceed \$97, 845 and under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-292037 and RR-293649.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
