galleries, totaling 4800 square feet, now accommodate MoPA's permanent collection and

traveling exhibitions simultaneously; and

WHEREAS, over the last 20 years, MoPA has hosted 162 exhibitions, 16 of which have

traveled nationally and internationally, and the museum has published 16 catalogues; NOW,
