RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO DECLARING A CONTINUED LOCAL
EMERGENCY DUE TO THE OCTOBER 2003 WILDFIRES

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 8630 authorizes local governing bodies to declare local emergencies when such events occur as described in California Government Code section 8558; and

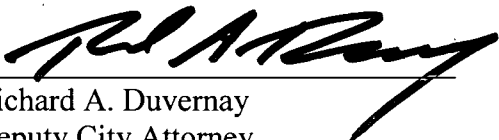
WHEREAS, on Monday, November 3, 2003, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-298565 declaring the existence of a state of emergency in the City of San Diego due to the burning of wildfires; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that such local emergency continues to exist in the City of San Diego as victims make efforts to demolish unsafe structures, protect eroded slopes and rebuild their homes and lives; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that pursuant to California Government Code section 8630, a continued state of local emergency is declared to exist in the City of San Diego due to the wildfires of October 2003.
