## RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 298780 ADOPTED ON A JAN 13 2004

WHEREAS, the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) wishes to provide grant funding for a program called RaceLegal, the purpose of which is to provide safe, supervised, legal alternatives to illegal street racing; to access information regarding the encouragement, enabling and operation of illegal street racing; to educate the public on the dangers of and alternatives to illegal racing; and to produce a "How To" manual, video and training seminars for communities with a high risk of illegal street racing; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City that this program be operated by 501(c)(3) Center for Injury Prevention, with the City of San Diego Police Department serving as applicant, administrative and fiscal agent; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police be, and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City Manager and the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept, manage and expend \$350,000 in grant funds from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) for the RaceLegal program for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by OTS.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to expend approximately \$330,806 of these grant funds for an agreement with the Center for Injury Prevention to operate the RaceLegal program, and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and that personnel positions, if any, funded under this program are not subject to local hiring freezes.
