WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department desires to apply for, and if awarded, accept, manage and expend a grant from the State of California Office of Traffic Safety, for a grant entitled, "Sobriety Checkpoint Program for Local Law Enforcement Agencies."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police be, and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept, manage and expend funds for the above named grant application, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 298809, including any extensions or amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that such authorization shall include all aspects of grant acceptance, operation, contracts, expenditures, and certifications, and that the City will comply with all applicable statutory and/or regulatory requirements related to this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police, on behalf of the City Manager, to accept, expend and administer any amendments, extensions, renewals, or future funding of this program for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the State of California.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds and/or resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
