WHEREAS, Fran Spear was raised in the Pacific Northwest and moved to San Diego, California in 1967, the same year she began her career with the City of San Diego, where she held various clerical positions in the Attorney's Office, Library, and Utilities Department; and

WHEREAS, in October 1975, she became a Litter Control Inspector for what is now the Environmental Services Department and was responsible for enforcing City codes pertaining to waste, including investigating complaints of illegal dumping and waste on public and private property, discouraging scavenging from curbside recycling bins, and issuing notices requiring that unsightly property violations be corrected; and

WHEREAS, Fran Spear planned and implemented over one hundred community cleanups in the southern part of the City, primarily in Council District Four, and throughout her career, Fran has described this aspect of her job as one of the most rewarding because of the interaction with many different members of the community, especially those who wanted to make a positive impact in their neighborhoods; and



She is an active member of her church and is known for her outstanding baking and cooking skills.
