WHEREAS, the dedicated Officers of the San Diego Police Department also became involved in fighting the fire in Scripps Ranch, and many Officers were instrumental in saving numerous homes throughout Scripps Ranch; and

WHEREAS, Officers of the San Diego Police Department were on duty protecting Scripps Ranch while 23 Officers had their own homes destroyed by the very same fire; and

WHEREAS, Officers of the San Diego Police Department sacrificed their personal lives by working long hours and multiple shifts to provide an incredible level of safety and protection for the Scripps Ranch area in the days and weeks following the fire; and

WHEREAS, Chief William Lansdowne and other high ranking Officers in the San Diego

Police Department provided the highest level of professionalism and coordination in working

together with the Fire-Rescue Department during this crisis, while still providing the entire City

of San Diego with important public safety services; and

WHEREAS, the community of Scripps Ranch is extremely proud and appreciative of

every Officer of the San Diego Police Department for saving lives, saving homes, protecting our

community and providing the highest level of public safety imaginable during the Cedar Fire and

its aftermath in late 2003; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and

on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby declare February 12, 2004, to be

"SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT DAY" in recognition of their outstanding service to

the Scripps Ranch community and the people of San Diego.
