RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO DECLARING AN END TO THE CONTINUED  
LOCAL EMERGENCY DUE TO THE OCTOBER 2003  
WILDFIRES

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 8630(d) provides that when local government has declared a Local Emergency pursuant to the Emergency Services Act, the governing body "shall proclaim the termination of the local emergency at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the conditions which necessitated the declaration of the local emergency due to the October 2003 Wildfires, including threats to public health and safety due to burned structures, fallen trees, and treats due to erosion, have been sufficiently abated to warrant the termination of the Local Emergency; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that pursuant to California Government Code section 8630(d), that the conditions which necessitated the declaration of a Local Emergency due to the October 2003 Wildfires have been sufficiently abated such that the Local Emergency can be terminated
