

RESOLUTION NUMBER R-298967

ADOPTED ON MAR 15 2004

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE GRANT.

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board [CIWMB] has established the Local Enforcement Agency Grant Program to provide grant funding to Local Enforcement Agencies to support the permitting and inspection of solid waste facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency [LEA] was certified in August 1999 by the CIWMB to carry out the duties and responsibilities of solid waste inspection, permitting and enforcement within the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the city of San Diego solid Waste LEA proposes to request grant funds for the purpose of purchasing computer equipment, software, office and technical equipment, office supplies, health and safety equipment, medical monitoring program, maintenance on existing equipment, training consulting services, laboratory services, reference materials, professional membership and for additional training of LEA staff to carry out the duties and responsibilities of solid waste inspection, permitting and enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Solid Waste LEA is eligible for approximately \$27,300 in grant funding (EA-15); NOW THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to submit an application to the CIWMB for a Local Enforcement Agency Grant and, if awarded, accept and expend grant funds.

2. That the City Manager is authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, grant agreements, amendments, payment requests, which may be necessary to carry out and administer the obligations, responsibilities, and duties of the City of San Diego Solid Waste LEA under the terms of the grant.

3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller are authorized to establish a separate fund for these funds.
