A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SAN DIEGO HOUSING COMMISSION TO APPLY FOR A U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO.

WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States named the City of San Diego the recipient of a grant of \$402,368 of Economic Development Initiative [EDI] funds to be used for development of transitional housing on Elm Street; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Rescue Mission [SDRM] applied to the Housing Commission to be the subrecipient of the EDI grant to fund rehabilitation of its Harbor View Project, a 379-bed transitional housing facility for the homeless located at 120 Elm Street; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Commission, in compliance with San Diego Municipal Code sections 98.031(d)(2) and 98.031(d)(8), may submit the grant application, receive the grant, and monitor compliance with Federal regulations governing use of the funds by the subrecipient; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the San Diego Housing Commission is authorized to apply for, accept, and disburse the EDI grant proceeds on behalf of the City of San Diego, as more particularly described in Housing Commission Report No. HCR04-10.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Determination with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and the California Office of Planning and Research regarding the approval of the funding application.
