WHEREAS, La Jolla Shores Drive serves as an important north-south transportation link in the La Jolla - La Jolla Shores - Torrey Pines Mesa area providing access for residents, employees, and visitors; and

WHEREAS, increasing traffic volumes on La Jolla Shores Drive and its cross streets results in traffic circulation and safety concerns by the residents and others; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has identified the intersection of La Jolla Shores

Drive and El Paseo Grande as a location where existing traffic volumes and turn movements

meet the requirements for the installation of a traffic signal; and

WHEREAS, because of budget constraints and the presence of numerous other projects with similar or higher rankings for funding, the City of San Diego would not be able to fully fund this signal for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, Scripps Institution of Oceanography has been located on La Jolla Shores

Drive since 1903 and existing and future development at SIO uses this intersection; and

WHEREAS, Ty Odeh is a La Jolla Shores resident who lives adjacent to this intersection and is an active participant in community affairs including service as a board member of the La Jolla Shores Association; and

WHEREAS, Scripps Institution of Oceanography, the University of California,

San Diego and Ty Odeh have recognized the positive benefits of improved traffic circulation and safety to all users of La Jolla Shores Drive and this intersection through the installation of a

traffic signal at La Jolla Shores Drive and El Paseo Grande, and have entered into a cooperative funding agreement with the City of San Diego Council District One to assure that the traffic signal is constructed as soon as possible; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, does hereby commend Ty Odeh for his generous contributions to the community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that March 29, 2004, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "TY ODEH DAY" in the City of San Diego.
