RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING
AN EXTENSION TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE ALLAN
COMPANY FOR THE MIRAMAR RECYCLING CENTER
SERVICE CONTRACT / REAL PROPERTY LEASE

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego [City] is required by California state law to reduce the amount of solid waste disposed in landfills by 50% and to make a good faith effort to implement programs as described in City's Source Reduction and Recycling Element; and

WHEREAS, the City's Environmental Services Department [ESD] operates many recycling and educational outreach programs to divert recyclables from the City's wastestream; and

WHEREAS, ESD requires a contractor to operate the Miramar Recycling Center [Center], located at the entrance to the City's Miramar Landfill, to provide a convenient location for the public to recycle; and

WHEREAS, in 2001, the San Diego City Council authorized the City Manager to execute the Miramar Recycling Center Service Contract/Real Property Lease [Agreement] with Allan Company [Contractor] for the operation of the Center, which Agreement is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Number RR-295859; and

WHEREAS, Contractor has spent a total of \$223,200 in permanent site improvements in the first two years of the Agreement; has increased customer usage 25 percent; and has expanded service to residents by accepting, at City's request, special handling items such as appliances containing Chlorofluorocarbons [CFC] (refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners), other appliances, and cathode ray tube [CRT] devices such as computer monitors and televisions.

At the City's request, Contractor has also provided free tax paper shredding and recycling during April, cooking oil recycling, and sale of bagged Miramar Greenery compost; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides for a five-year initial term and includes an evergreen clause which, beginning at the end of the second contract year and at the end of each contract year thereafter, allows for a one-year extension of the Agreement if mutually agreed upon by the parties and approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement is nearing the end of the second year, and ESD and Contractor have mutually agreed upon a one-year extension to the Agreement under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Extension to the Agreement; and


WHEREAS, extending the Agreement will allow Contractor to continue providing high quality services in support of the City's efforts to meet State mandated waste diversion goals; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a one-year contract extension to the Agreement with Allan Company for the operation of the Miramar Recycling Center under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Extension to Miramar Recycling Center Service Contract/ Real Property Lease on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 299012.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to deposit revenues received under the First Extension to the Agreement in Fund No. 41210 – Recycling Fund.
