A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING GRANT APPLICATION FOR FUNDING OF A PEDESTRIAN MASTER PLAN.

WHEREAS, the California Office of Traffic Safety [COTS] and the San Diego
Association of Governments [SANDAG], as the regional administrator of the Transportation
Development Act claims program, awards grants to local agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to develop a Citywide Pedestrian Master Plan [Master Plan], which will identify infrastructure improvement projects that promote pedestrian safety, walkability, mobility, accessibility and neighborhood quality goals; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for grant funding for a total amount of \$761,800 from COTS and SANDAG, to be used for the development of the Master Plan; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to apply to COTS for grant funding in the amount of \$611,800, for development of the Master Plan.
- 2. That the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to apply to SANDAG for grant funding in the amount of \$150,000, for development of the Master Plan.
- 3. That the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to take all necessary actions to secure and accept grant funds from COTS and SANDAG for development of the Master Plan,

and is authorized to submit all documents and to negotiate and execute all agreements necessary to comply with COTS's and SANDAG's grant requirements.

- 4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend grant funds, if the grants are secured.
- 5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized and directed to establish special interest-bearing funds for the grants, if secured.
