BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any liability arising out of our performance of this

Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of

the City of San Diego. The State of California and the California Office of Traffic Safety disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds and/or resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
