

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 299074

ADOPTED ON APR 12 2004

WHEREAS, the Old Police Headquarters building at 700 W. Harbor Drive is a symbol of law enforcement in San Diego and previously served as home to the San Diego Police Department for nearly 50 years; and

WHEREAS, during this time the San Diego Police Department rose to national prominence; and

WHEREAS, the Old Police Headquarters building is one of only 25 police facilities in the history of the United States to be designated a national historic site and listed on the National Register of Historic Places; and


WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Historical Association has carefully documented the historical significance of the building and expressed their support in providing reuse possibilities for the Old Police Headquarters; and

WHEREAS, the Old Police Headquarters is a regional asset and architecturally significant building which can serve the citizens of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, adaptive reuse studies have shown the Old Police Headquarters is entirely reusable and a police museum is feasible at this location; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, does hereby declare Monday, April 12, 2004, to be **“OLD POLICE HEADQUARTERS DAY”** in the City of San Diego.
