

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 299115

ADOPTED ON APR 26 2004

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's "6 to 6" Extended School Day Program was initiated in 1998 with limited funding; and

WHEREAS, over time the City has been successful in significantly increasing the amount of funds available to serve over 25,000 students; and

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2003, the City Council adopted R-298024 to accept the State of California Department of Education grant funds for the fiscal years 2003 through 2007; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption, additional funds have been granted for fiscal years 2004 through 2006; and

WHEREAS, this expansion represents \$245,744 additional grant funds per year for FY 2004, 2005, and 2006, for a three year total of \$737,232; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds are passed to the City by the San Diego Unified School District; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept additional State of California Department of Education grant funds (After School Education and Safety Program (ASESP) state grant funds) awarded to San Diego's "6 to 6" Extended School Day Program and to enter into agreements to expend these funds beginning FY 2004 through FY 2006 for an amount not to exceed \$245,744 per year, for a three year total of \$737,232.

2. That the City Manager is authorized to amend the 2004 Memorandum of Understanding [MOU] with the San Diego Unified School District to reflect the additional grant funds, when executed shall be placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR 299115.

3. That the additional funding for the City of San Diego's "6 to 6" program is contingent upon execution of San Diego Unified School District's MOU.
