RESOLUTION AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY
NO. 900-11 REGARDING ARTIST(S) INVOLVEMENT
IN SELECTED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego adopted existing Council Policy 900-11 by Resolution R-279659 dated March 30, 1992; and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 900-11 does not outline specific funding sources for the Public Art Program; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on March 17, 2004, the Natural Resources and Culture Committee voted unanimously to direct that an amendment to Council Policy No. 900-11 be drafted to provide for the inclusion of public art in eligible public improvement projects undertaken by the City and the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that Council Policy No. 900-11 titled, "Artist(s) Involvement in Selected Capital Improvement Projects," is amended as set forth in the Council Policy on file in the office of the City Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission for Arts and Culture is directed to return to the Council of the City of San Diego to report on the status and the progress of the Public Art Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that staff is directed to clarify the language under the "Policy Applicability" section of the Council Policy to reflect the fact that the Council Policy would not apply to construction which consists solely of roads, streets, highways, or arterials.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is instructed to add the aforesaid to the Council Policy Manual.
