WHEREAS, the members of Emergency Medical Services teams engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and continuing education to enhance their lifesaving skills; and

WHEREAS, San Diegans benefit greatly from the knowledge and expertise of these highly trained individuals and from the services that they provide every day to the public; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby recognize the dedicated men and women in emergency medical services whose selfless efforts help save and protect the lives of those living in our community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that May 16-22, 2004, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES WEEK" in the City of San Diego.
