RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING
THE EXECUTION OF THE FIFTH AMENDED UNIFIED SAN
DIEGO COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is a participating signatory to the Fourth Amended Unified San Diego County Emergency Services Agreement, which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-288274, adopted on January 27, 1997; and



WHEREAS, the primary purposes of the Unified San Diego County Emergency Services Organization [ESO] are to coordinate and facilitate regional emergency plans and programs which are intended to preserve the life and safety of people and property, and to make provisions for the execution of plans, programs, and for mutual assistance in the event of multi-jurisdictional emergencies or disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Fifth Amended Unified San Diego County Emergency Services Agreement, which is on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 299227 continues to serve the above purposes while also making changes to the voting system, creating a joint powers agreement, naming the County Treasurer as the depositary and custodian of all the money of the ESO, and describing the responsibilities of the County Treasurer; NOW
THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Manager, Director of the Office of Homeland Security, or their respective designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the City, the Fifth Amended Unified San Diego County Emergency Services Agreement, under the terms and conditions set forth in the

Agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-_____,
together with any reasonably necessary modifications or amendments thereto which do not
increase project scope or cost and which the City Manager shall deem necessary from time to
time in order to carry out the purposes and intent of this project and agreement.
