A RESOLUTION APPOINTING ELLEN OPPENHEIM, DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT, TO SERVE AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN DIEGO MODEL SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified School District, the City of San Diego, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, and the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego have agreed that a joint effort would facilitate the planning, financing, and construction of a new elementary school, multifamily mixed-income and for-sale housing, recreation opportunities and park space, neighborhood commercial uses, additional family services, and other complementary facilities; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2002, the City Council, the Redevelopment Agency, and the Housing Authority each approved entering into a joint powers agreement [JPA] forming the San Diego Model School Development Agency [Agency] to achieve these goals; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is entitled by the JPA to appoint a representative to the board of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2002, the City appointed then Assistant Manager Lamont Ewell as its representative to the Board of the Agency, and Mr. Ewell's expanded responsibilities as City Manager no longer permit his participation; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that

Ellen Oppenheim, Director of Parks and Recreation Department, shall be appointed to the Board

of the San Diego Model School Development Agency to serve on behalf of the City of San Diego.
