## RESOLUTION NUMBER R-299247 ADOPTED ON MAY 1 8 2004

WHEREAS, California Streets and Highways Code section 8330 et seq. and San Diego Municipal Code [SDMC] Chapter 12, Article 5, Division 9, provides a procedure for the summary vacation of public easement by City Council resolution where the easement is no longer required; and

WHEREAS, the affected property owner has requested the vacation of the water utility easement within, to unencumber this property and facilitate development of the site Casa de Las Campañas facility as conditioned in approved conditional use permit and water utility easement abandonment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that:

- (a) there is no present or prospective use for the water utility easement either for the purpose for which it was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated; and
  - (b) the public will benefit from the vacation through improved utilization of land; and
  - (c) the vacation is consistent with the General Plan or an approved Community Plan; and
- (d) the public water utility easement system for which the right-of-way was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by this vacation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the water utility easement located within Casa de Las Campañas property, in Rancho Bernardo community area, in connection with conditional use permit, as more particularly described in the legal description marked as Exhibit "A," and shown on Drawing No. 11273, marked as Exhibit "B," and on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Nos. RR-299247-1, and RR-299247-2, which are by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is ordered vacated.

2. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, with attached exhibits, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder.

## EXHIBIT "A" WATER EASEMENT ABANDONMENT
