

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 299257

ADOPTED ON MAY 24 2004

WHEREAS, state law created in the state treasury an Indian Gaming Revenue Sharing Trust Fund and an Indian Gaming Special Distribution Fund; and

WHEREAS, State Senate Bill 621 established methods and criteria for distribution these funds to local government agencies impacted by tribal gaming; and

WHEREAS, representatives of local tribes have invited the San Diego Police Department to apply for the specific equipment and resources in the amount of approximately \$843,721, as detailed in the applications for the requested funds, copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Documents RR- 299257, RR- 299257-2, RR- 299257-3 and RR- 299257-4, and


WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department has prepared applications for these funds;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police be, and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept, manage and expend these grants, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals, for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the State of California.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to execute all aspects of program operation, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals, and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
