A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO EXECUTE A JOINT EXERCISE OF POWERS AGREEMENT TO CONSOLIDATE ARJIS AND SAN DIEGO ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS (SANDAG)

WHEREAS, the Automated Regional Justice Information System (hereinafter ARJIS) provides an invaluable resource to law enforcement officers in the City of San Diego by providing information which can be used to solve crimes, identify suspects, and enhance officer and public safety and the City of San Diego desires to improve and enhance the capabilities and administration of ARJIS; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Association of Governments (hereinafter SANDAG) through its Criminal Justice Research Division conducts analysis of crime trends, engages in outreach and community collaboration, is a resource for criminal justice information, and conducts programs evaluations; and

WHEREAS, SANDAG has the ability to enhance the capabilities and administration of ARJIS; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement between the City of San Diego and SANDAG would benefit the City of San Diego by providing for increased capabilities and improved administration of ARJIS; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Exercise of Powers Act (Section 6500 et. seq. of the California Government Code) permits public agencies to jointly exercise any power common to them by entering into an agreement for that purpose that is authorized by the respective governing bodies of the public agencies; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of San Diego, that the Mayor of the City of San Diego is authorized to execute a Joint Powers Agreement with the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG), substantially in the form of and on the terms set forth in the "JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT-AS AMENDED JANUARY 2004-AUTOMATED REGIONAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM JOINT POWERS AGENCY" on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 299315
