WHEREAS, the Filipino-American population in San Diego is one of the largest concentrations of Filipinos outside the Republic of the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, the Filipino-American community has made many contributions to our City and continues to enhance and enrich the cultural diversity of San Diego; and


WHEREAS, this year marks the 106th anniversary of Philippine independence from Spain; and
