WHEREAS, the Kensington/ Normal Heights Branch Library offers many services and programs to the community, such as free public internet access, a summer reading program, free children's programs throughout the year, an annual essay contest, and story times on Tuesday mornings and Wednesday evenings; and

WHEREAS, to honor the commemoration of the 50th birthday of the library, the Grand Marshals in the 2004 Kensington Memorial Day Parade are Kensington/ Normal Heights Branch librarians Patricia Karnes (1993-1996), Jack Albrecht (1996-2002) and current librarian Kathy Baker; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the citizens of San Diego, does hereby commend the staff and volunteers of the Kensington/Normal Heights Branch Library for their outstanding commitment to serving the communities of Kensington and Normal Heights and congratulates the community upon the celebration of the library's 50th birthday.
