ADOPTED ON JUN 28 2004

WHEREAS, Sister Linda was one of the 14 sisters who founded the Community of the Holy Spirit in 1970, coming together with other like-minded sisters to create a self-governed community, dedicated to service in the community, where sisters could choose their own work; and

WHEREAS, Sister Linda obtained a degree in school administration from the University of San Diego, and served as principal of Holy Trinity School, starting in 1970; and

WHEREAS, working with Catholic Charities, Sister Linda helped start the House of Rachel and served as a mentor to many of the women who went there to rebuild their lives and bring themselves out of homelessness; and

WHEREAS, Sister Linda served as secretary at the Newman Center, a Catholic center for students, faculty, and staff of UCSD; and

WHEREAS, as principal of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart School, Sister Linda initiated strong alumni programs, and with the help of the alumni, was able to raise funds to support the school, sponsor tuition for students in need, and develop a new playground; and


WHEREAS, Sister Linda is a dedicated educator who has been the principal at Our Lady of the Sacred Heart School for the past 11 years, where she began a highly successful and much-needed preschool program and developed an excellent "6-to-6" before and after school program; and

WHEREAS, Sister Linda has been a longtime community organizer and member of the San Diego Organizing Project, where she has advocated on behalf of the community that she serves; NOW, THEREFORE,
