

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 299399

ADOPTED ON JUN 28 2004

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO INCREASE
SEWER CAPACITY CHARGES.

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 64.0410 provides that sewer capacity charges [Capacity Charges] may be established by resolution of the City Council upon giving ten days notice of intention to establish, amend, or increase such charges; and

WHEREAS, the City has undertaken a cost of service study [Study] to evaluate whether the City's current Capacity Charges are achieving full cost recovery from new connections to the City Sewer System; and

WHEREAS, the Study concluded that the City needs to increase its Capacity Charges in order to achieve full cost recovery; and

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2004, the City Council approved Resolution No. R-299321 authorizing the City Manager to increase Capacity Charges to achieve full cost recovery; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has deemed it appropriate to allow applications for "construction permits" (as that term is defined in San Diego Municipal Code section 113.0103) [Construction Permits] that are "deemed complete" (as that term is defined in San Diego Municipal Code section 113.0103) [Deemed Complete] on or before June 30, 2004, to be subject to the Capacity Charges in effect as of June 30, 2004 [2004 Rates]; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that notwithstanding the adoption of the Capacity Charges pursuant to Resolution No. 299321, applications for

Construction Permits that are Deemed Complete on or before June 30, 2004 shall be subject to the 2004 Rate for only one year from the date such applications for Construction Permits are Deemed Complete.
