WHEREAS, on October 13, 2003, the City Council adopted an ordinance which is on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. O-19224, and codified at San Diego Municipal Code section 26.04 renaming the Energy Advisory Board to Sustainable Energy Advisory Board and adding provisions relating to renewable energy goals and board appointments; and

WHEREAS, the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board is to serve as an advisory body to the Mayor, City Council, and City Manager on energy policy and future energy needs for the metropolitan San Diego area and to assist the City's attainment of its energy independence and renewable energy goals; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance requires the Mayor to appoint nine members and they will be confirmed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance requires that there shall be seven designated members and two at-large members; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2004, the City Council adopted an amendment to the ordinance, which is on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. O-19295, which added two at-large alternate members to the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance requires that the members shall serve two year terms and each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance requires that the members shall be appointed in such manner that the terms of not more than five members shall expire in any year; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance requires the expiration date of all terms shall be March 1; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointments by the Mayor of the City of San Diego, to serve as alternates on the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board, for terms ending March 1, 2006, be and the same are hereby confirmed:
