ADOPTED ON JUL 13 2004

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,000 AND AMENDING AND INCREASING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET NO. 61-103-7 TO INCLUDE THE \$75,000 IN REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT CONTRIBUTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Midway Community contains some of the most congested streets within the City of San Diego [City]; and

WHEREAS, the traffic congestion negatively effects the reliability of transit service within the area; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Association of governments [SANDAG] plans to create a Bus Rapid Transit [BRT] system in the North Bay Redevelopment Project Area running between the Old Town Transit Center [OTTC] and Pacific Beach; and

WHEREAS, the OTTC Queue Jump Project [Project] developed by SANDAG would provide the infrastructure needed for the future BRT system and improve current bus service; and

WHEREAS, the Project would reduce traffic congestion by allowing the existing bus service to run more efficiently, reduce the back up of vehicular traffic on Rosecrans Street, and improve general-purpose and transit flow through the intersection; and

WHEREAS, to expedite the Project, the Agency offered to help fund construction of the queue jump; and


WHEREAS, on March 30, 2004, the Redevelopment Agency approved the appropriation and expenditure of \$225,000 and the Council and Agency made certain findings with respect to the payment of funds; and

WHEREAS, by combining this Project with an existing City traffic signal modification project at the same intersection, the total amount of Agency contribution has decreased to \$100,000; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the Council accepts the transfer of funds from the Redevelopment Agency in the amount of \$75,000; and
2. That the Council amends and increases the Capital Improvement Program Budget No. 61-103-7 to include the \$75,000 in redevelopment Agency public improvement contributions.
