BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council initiates the plan amendment process to revise the location site of Fire Station No. 48 from the northeast

portion of the Black Mountain Ranch Subarea to the southeast portion of the Black Mountain Ranch Subarea, north of Carmel Valley Road.
