A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO THE PAYMENT FOR THE 30<sup>th</sup> STREET MID-BLOCK LIGHTING PROJECT IN THE NORTH PARK REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA; ACCEPTING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$90,000; AND AMENDING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET NO. 39-092.0 TO INCLUDE \$90,000.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [the Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the North Park Redevelopment Project; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan, the Agency proposes to pay for the purchase and installation of 20 ornamental light fixtures for the 30<sup>th</sup> Street Mid-Block Lighting Project [Project]; and


WHEREAS, the current length of 30<sup>th</sup> Street between El Cajon Boulevard and Adams Avenue would benefit from additional lighting; and

WHEREAS, the Council has duly considered all conditions of the proposed payment for the rehabilitation project and believes that the payment by the Agency for part of the cost of the project is in the best interest of the City and the health, safety and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposes and provisions of applicable State and local law requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That it finds and determines that the 30<sup>th</sup> Street Mid-Block Lighting Project [Project] for which the Agency proposes to pay a portion of is of benefit to the North Park Redevelopment Project; that it finds and determines that no other reasonable means for financing the Project are available to the community; that it finds and determines that the Project will assist in eliminating one or more blighting conditions inside the Project Area; and that it finds and determines that the Project is consistent with the Implementation Plan adopted by the Agency pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 33490.
2. That it accepts the transfer of funds from the Agency in the amount of \$ 90,000.
3. That it amends and increases Capital Improvement Program Budget No. 39-092.0 to include the \$90,000 in Agency public improvement contributions.
