



Section 3

ASSESSMENT OF COST AND EXPENSE

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the maintenance and expense of the contemplated maintenance are made chargeable upon the Districts, and the Council does declare that certain properties within the Districts receive special benefit from the maintenance of the improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council shall assess those properties within the Districts which receive a special benefit from the maintenance for the total amount of the



maintenance costs of the Districts, plus incidental expenses thereto, to be received by the individual parcels of real property within the Districts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council may order a portion of the costs of maintenance to be paid by the City from appropriate funds. The proposed budget for the Districts are as follows:
