RESOLUTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT FISCAL YEAR 2005
ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS ON THE DOWNTOWN
PROPERTY AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
PREVIOUSLY REVIEWED AND APPROVED IN THE CITY
BUDGET REVIEW PROCESS ON JUN 15 2004.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council hereby authorizes the levy and collection of assessments in the City for the Fiscal Year 2005 pursuant to the provisions of the California Streets and Highways Code section 36600 *et seq.* to pay a proscribed portion of the cost of future maintenance of improvements. These improvements are more generally described in the assessment engineer's report, submitted in connection with the Downtown Property and Business Improvement District [District] and on file in the Office of the City Clerk:

Section 1

DESCRIPTION OF AUTHORIZED ACTIVITIES

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the maintenance consists in general of the maintenance of those improvements contained in the assessment management plan [Plan] and submitted in connection with the District, and filed in the Office of the City Clerk as Document Number RR- 299498.

Section 2

DESCRIPTION OF THE DISTRICT

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District is described as follows:

All that real property in the City of San Diego included within the exterior boundary lines of the maps designated as the District, filed in the Office of the City Clerk as the Downtown PBID Engineer's Report, Document Number: M- 502-05 (34), excepting therefrom all public streets, roads, alleys, avenues and highways. Reference is hereby made to the map and the Report for a further and more particular description of the District, so on file. Such map and Report shall govern for all details as to the extent of the District.

Section 3

ASSESSMENT OF COST AND EXPENSE

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the maintenance and expense of the contemplated maintenance are made chargeable upon the District, and the Council does declare that certain properties within the District receive special benefit from the maintenance of the improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that reference is hereby made to the Report for a statement of the assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the District.
