

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 299594

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department has been selected to receive a grant, a copy of which is on record with the City Clerk as Document Number RR 299594, via the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the purpose of expanding the Homeless Outreach Team (HOT), an existing partnership with the Community Research Foundation Psychiatric Emergency Response Team; and

WHEREAS, the funds from the grant will be used to provide valuable resources to assist homeless persons in the City of Dan Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police be, and is hereby, authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for, accept, manage and expend this grant, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals, for a period of up to five years, provided funding is made available by the federal government.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police be, and is hereby, authorized and empowered to enter into a contractual agreement with the Psychiatric Emergency Response Team to allocate a portion of these grant funds to support their participation in this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to execute all aspects of program operation, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals, and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to this program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
